Wheel Collision warrants that your alloy wheels have been repaired in accordance with the SABS SANS 1158 Standard (the South African national standard for alloy wheel repair)

- A. The following warranties are provided on work carried out by Wheel Collision:
 - A.1. A limited lifetime warranty on workmanship. Workmanship means work carried out by Wheel Collision and does not include any new damage be it structural or cosmetic and OEM specifications.
 - A.2. Manufacturer's Warranty on paintwork where wheels have been refurbished or customised.
- B. This limited warranty is the sole express warranty given by Wheel Collision and is in lieu of all other express warranties, whether oral or written. All implied warranties, including, without limitation, liability for special, incidental, or consequential damages. Before the tyre is mounted, ensure that the following has been checked: (failure to follow these steps will void any warranty that may be applicable).
 - B.1. Check that the product, colour, bolt pattern (PCD) and fitment is correct.
 - B.2. Check for protrusions on the hub mounting face. Ensure that wheels are clear of any screws, rivets, retaining clips or balancing weights.
 - B.3. The wheels do not come in contact with any of the front or rear hubs, brake callipers, braking or suspension components of the vehicle.
- C. If due to the workmanship by Wheel Collision, and while the vehicle is operated under normal driving conditions, the paint and/or clear coat chips or flakes, or other defects in the surface occur that are determined to be the result of workmanship, Wheel Collision will repair that alloy wheel subject to the terms and conditions below.

D. Some high gloss finishes show blemishes more readily (depending on the condition of the alloy wheels). In some of these cases we cannot guarantee a perfect finish, this is normally only noticeable on close inspection and not noticeable when alloy wheel is on the car.

WARRANTY TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- The warranty is automatically void on any alloy wheel repaired by Wheel Collision that has been altered in any manner, including but not limited to as PCD, offset, centre bore, repaired or any of the following conditions:
 - 1.1. Wash damage, chemicals, caustic cleaning agents, de-greaser, and climate conditions.
 - 1.2. Any appearance defect (scratches) on alloy wheels that have been damaged during mounting.
 - Any defect, malfunction or failure caused by, offroad use, abuse, accident, or negligence caused by any involved party.
- Any alloy wheel repaired by Wheel Collision that does not conform to this warranty will be after it has been inspected and the claimed damages are verified as covered by this warranty.
 - Such repair shall not include removal or installation of any tyre.
 - 2.2. If returned wheel is found not to be subject to warranty coverage, the alloy wheel will be returned to the sender, without repair, at the sender's expense where applicable.
- A warranty claim only covers the re-repair of the affected wheel(s). No other claims for costs arising as a result of the re-repair, either directly or indirectly, will be accepted.
- 4. No warranty is offered for centre caps.
